



Birth Choice Story and Fact Sheet

Client Stories from 2022:

(All of these babies were saved after Roe v. Wade's reversal!)

1. *Since the overturn of Roe v. Wade many have asked us, "What will Birth Choice be doing now?" Our answer is always emphatically the same. We will be doing exactly what we have always done for more than 33 years. We will be sharing truth with each and every man and woman who comes to us. Truth about their preborn child created in the very image of God and truth about the gospel of Jesus Christ. We will give them that truth in love, as we strive to be the hands and feet of our Savior. The truth given in love is a powerful weapon against the enemy. As a result, over and over again the majority of our abortion-determined clients choose life for their children.*

"Jessica" was one such woman who came to Birth Choice not long after the overturn of Roe. She was in a very emotional and difficult situation and felt she had no choice, but to have an abortion. Her fiancée found out she was pregnant and broke off their engagement. "Jessica" told her client advocate, Ranelle, that she had already contacted an abortion clinic in another state who told her they would pay her travel expenses and hotel costs. So very lovingly, Ranelle shared truth in love with "Jessica."

Before "Jessica" left our office, Ranelle also gave this young woman her personal phone number in the hope she would continue to reach out to her. Several weeks later she received this text. "Hello Mrs. Ranelle, this is "Jessica." Sorry I didn't reply sooner. The truth is that I was still unsure and had an abortion planned for September 24th. [But] I couldn't bring myself to do it and I'm welcoming a baby boy [in March]. I know it won't be easy, but I will fight through the adversity."

2. *One young woman came to us considering abortion because of her relationship with the father of the baby. Ashley (pseudonym) knew she would be left to raise her child alone, and she knew it would be hard both physically and financially. However, she enjoyed talking with her Client Advocate about all her pregnancy options and received life-affirming information. Ashley opened up about some hard things that had happened in her life. Then she saw her ultrasound and was happy to see an active baby with a strong heartbeat. Ashley still could have traveled out of state for an abortion, but she chose life!*
3. *Elise (pseudonym) was planning to have an abortion for several reasons. She has a son with a disability, there are hard family dynamics, and she just wasn't ready for another child. Elise has a supportive husband and family and she didn't want to go through an*



abortion, but she also didn't want a baby. When she came to our Gibson County clinic, her Client Advocate shared the gospel with her, prayed with her, and gave her a Bible. She also gave her a pair of homemade baby booties and other information. Elise left still planning to abort, but at her follow-up ultrasound appointment she chose life!

- 4. People have many reasons for considering abortion, and sometimes that reason is the baby's ethnicity. Abby (pseudonym) began to cry as she told her Client Advocate that her father did not approve of the pregnancy because of the color of her boyfriend's skin. Her dad said some really hurtful things to her, and that was the whole reason she wanted an abortion. After talking with her Client Advocate, Abby chose life and saw her beautiful 16-week baby on ultrasound! Please pray Abby's father will soften toward Abby, her boyfriend, and their baby.*
- 5. Emma (pseudonym) came in considering abortion because of her mom's pressure. She called Planned Parenthood when she first found out she was pregnant, but came to Birth Choice first! After seeing the baby's heartbeat on ultrasound, she said it was stressful thinking of ending the baby's life. She left happy and planning to give life to her baby!*
- 6. Madelyn (pseudonym) had considered abortion when she first found out she was pregnant but was leaning toward parenting when she came to Birth Choice. During her discussion with her Client Advocate, Madelyn kept looking at the little fetal model and said, "you mean to tell me that he has arms and legs and all?" This is why education on fetal development is so important, even for women who have already had children! When the nurse asked what her decision for the pregnancy was, she said, "I don't want to hurt my youngest's feelings and get rid of her baby sister or brother." We are so thankful for this changed heart, and also for the opportunity God gave us to share truth in someone's life.*
- 7. Chloe (pseudonym) had an abortion scheduled the day she called Birth Choice in early October, but the abortion clinic (in another state) called and told her the price would double for the procedure. She was a previous client of ours, so she made an appointment with Birth Choice instead! She was undecided when she came to us but chose life after seeing her ultrasound. Praise God!*

Abortion Facts:

- All elective abortions are illegal in Tennessee! Praise the Lord!
- The Sanctity of Human Life remains the same.
- There are still women in West TN who are considering abortion; unplanned pregnancies are not stopping just because abortion is illegal in our state. Many women plan to travel to Illinois, which has the closest abortion clinic to us.
- Over 63 million babies aborted since the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision in 1973.
- 3,303: approximate number of abortions in the U.S. every weekday based on 2018 data.
2,977: number of people who died during the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks
- 1.67 billion: number of people aborted worldwide since 1980. 1.4 billion: number of people living in China, the most populated country in the world.
