In both the Old and New Testaments, there are several instances where God spoke to people through dreams and visions. The implication is that these encounters can happen while asleep or while fully awake. I'll have to confess that most of my "sleeping dreams" tend to be connected more to the past than the future.

For years, my most recurring dreams involved being able to dunk a basketball again, hit a softball over the fence, or even having my leg grow back after my amputation. All of these dreams were rooted in things I once could do or possessed — things that are no longer part of my life. More recently, my recurring dreams involve running long distances again or returning to my CrossFit workouts. Once again, these are activities I've had to give up, yet in my dreams I perform them with ease.

There are other odd things about my dreams as well. If I'm having a bad dream, I can sometimes literally wake myself up, go back to sleep, and change the circumstances — even the outcome. On several occasions, I've even experienced what felt like dreaming three layers deep: dreaming that I was dreaming about dreaming.

As strange and absurd as dreams and visions during sleep can sometimes be, it has always brought me comfort knowing that the most important dreams and visions come while I am awake. I'm not talking about daydreaming or simply imagining things I would like to do. Rather, I'm referring to the dream of accomplishing as much as possible for God's Kingdom and envisioning lives directed by God's promises for those committed to His plans, whatever they may be.

The many-faceted responsibilities of the growing Birth Choice ministry can sometimes feel daunting as we continually adapt to an ever-changing world. But this is what we know for sure: we can never outdream God, nor can we envision accomplishments greater than what He has planned for all of us in the Christian life.

After the presentation, the Director of Men's Mentoring and Abstinence Education at Birth Choice meets with the boys as female staff members meet with the girls. This allows time for Q & A in a comfortable, non-judgmental setting. Parents and church leaders are welcome and encouraged to be a part of the audience. A six-week Bible Study is also available for youth leaders to use.

defend life in the womb, and brought it all back to the gospel. As Dr. Lile says, “the baby in the womb is your neighbor.”

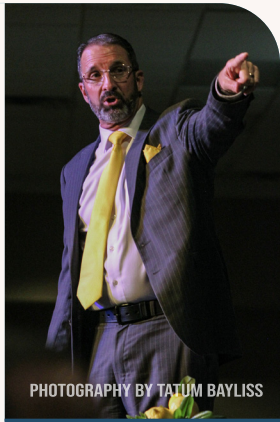

FROM THE HEART OF A CLIENT ADVOCATE

Almost 20 years ago, a family member had an unplanned pregnancy and came to Birth Choice. She was able to have access to the much-needed prenatal/parenting classes and resources they offered. I thought then that I would one day like to help at Birth Choice, but I was busy raising a family. Time went by and I did have more time. Once again, the Lord reminded me about Birth Choice, yet still I kept putting it off, again thinking “one day...”

Sometime later, on a Sunday, Birth Choice had a ministry table at our church and the Lord strongly impressed on me that “one day” was now! I was told their greatest need was for client advocates, yet that seemed more than I could handle. I felt the Lord speak to my heart, though, and I knew this was what He wanted me to do. I went through training and I’ve now been serving for 8 years as a client advocate!

I love spending time with women each week and hearing their stories. Some are excited about their pregnancies, and I get to share about the resources we have to help them. Others are unsure about their future, so I love that I get to listen, educate them about their options, and offer them an ultrasound. What a privilege to also get to share the hope of the gospel with each client. I have been so blessed by this ministry and hope others who feel the Lord stirring their hearts won’t wait as long as I did!

FROM THE HEART OF A SECURITY TEAM MEMBER

I remember the exact moment when I saw a post on my church forum asking if there were any men who were willing to volunteer as security, or “Man on the Premises,” at Birth Choice. The thought of volunteering at Birth Choice never really crossed my mind, but as soon as I saw the post, I knew this was something I could do and wanted to do. As someone who is involved with the security team at my church, the safety of God’s people is important to me. Now I have the privilege of helping with the safety of Birth Choice volunteers and, more importantly, the safety of the lives of unborn babies and their mothers.

As my time at Birth Choice has increased, what I do has grown to be more than just volunteering as security; it has also become a teaching opportunity for my children. When they ask me where I’m going and why I’m not eating dinner with my family on a given night, I tell them that I am going to help people feel safe so that they can help save the lives of babies in their mama’s tummy. This helps my kids to see the importance and value of the life of every unborn child. There are times when the night is slow and no one comes in, or skips out on their appointment, but I know that what I do matters and helps to protect the life of the unborn. I love serving as a Birth Choice security team member.

MOBILE MEDICAL UNIT UPDATE

One of the greatest gifts of serving in this ministry is the opportunity to walk alongside the women who come through our mobile clinic doors each day. Each woman carries her own story—sometimes filled with uncertainty, fear, or loneliness—and yet in each encounter, we are reminded of the dignity and worth God has placed within her.

This work is not simply about services or conversations; it is about relationship. It is about meeting someone exactly where she is, listening without judgment, and offering compassion rooted in truth. Time and again, we see how even a small moment of caring—a kind word, a patient ear, a gentle reassurance—can make a lasting difference.

We are continually humbled by the strength of the women we meet. Many are facing difficult

circumstances, yet they show courage in seeking support and considering their next steps. It is a privilege to be present with them, to offer practical help, and to remind them that they are not alone.

For our team, this ministry is also transformative. Each conversation strengthens our faith, deepens our compassion, and renews our sense of purpose. We are reminded daily that this work is not ours alone, but part of something greater—guided by grace and sustained by hope.

ADOPTION AGENCY NEWS!

We believe physical adoption reflects a greater spiritual reality. As we share the heart of adoption, we point to God's redemption story and His invitation for us to be adopted into His family. Through this, our hope is to gently help break down the belief that abortion is easier or better, replacing it with truth, dignity, and hope.

Our goal is simple: no one walks this journey alone. We recognize that poor decisions are often made when women are alone, narrowing what they perceive to be possible. Likewise, children who grow up without consistent support often become young men and women facing the consequences of those same patterns. This is a cycle we are committed to stepping into—with faith, presence, care, and truth.

To truly live out a pro-life calling, it is crucial that we prayerfully ask, "What is my part?" We are not here to convince anyone to adopt through our agency, but to encourage surrender and discernment—whether God is calling someone to foster

care, private adoption, embryo adoption, another agency, international, or to support in others way.

As we build this program, we are working to faithfully support every side of adoption, as well as the church and community. Our adoptions will range from openness, semi-open, to fully open, depending on what is healthiest for those involved. We are committed to walking with families long after placement, helping navigate and support relationships over time. We are also pursuing TBRI practitioner training so we can provide this valuable support to families and our community.

A current need is providing Christian clinical counseling for birth mothers, as we believe this is essential for their hope and healing.

Together, each of us has a role to play—so that no one is alone.
